



Peace River Center's Club Success is part of a program certified by Clubhouse International, which includes more than 370 Clubhouses in 32 countries throughout the world.

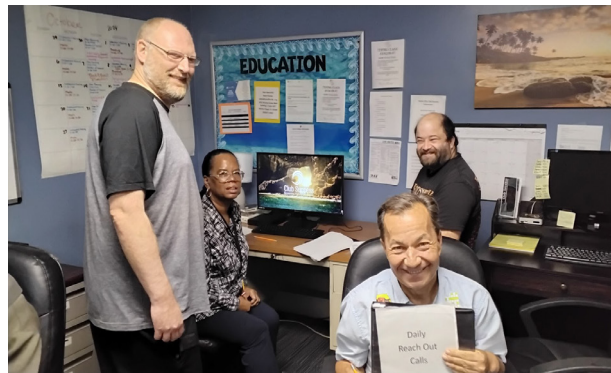
About Club Success

Club Success is a recovery program for people with mental illness and attendees are called members rather than patients or clients. Club members learn responsibility, develop self-esteem, and learn to interact professionally. The clubhouse provides members with transitional employment opportunities through local community partners, guidance to secure housing, and/or continue their education. It also promotes members' on-going psychiatric care, while maintaining government benefits.



Work-Ordered Day

The Clubhouse model is designed to mirror a mainstream day in the workplace by applying the Meaningful Work Philosophy. Members learn real life job skills—they are taught and achieve meaningful work as a contributing member of society. Members are responsible for using their abilities to help others and build relationships, while working closely with staff and colleagues. The Work-Ordered Day (WOD) allows members to practice a variety of skills and gain confidence.



The Clubhouse Effect

Since opening in 2005, Club Success has served more than 1,000 members. We currently serve members at our Lakeland and Haines City locations. Clubhouses provided a variety of benefits including:

- Reduced Psychiatric Hospitalizations
- Reduced Incarcerations
- Increased Well-Being
- Increased Employment

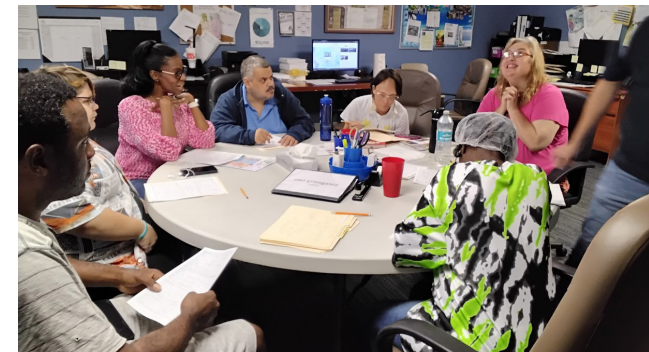

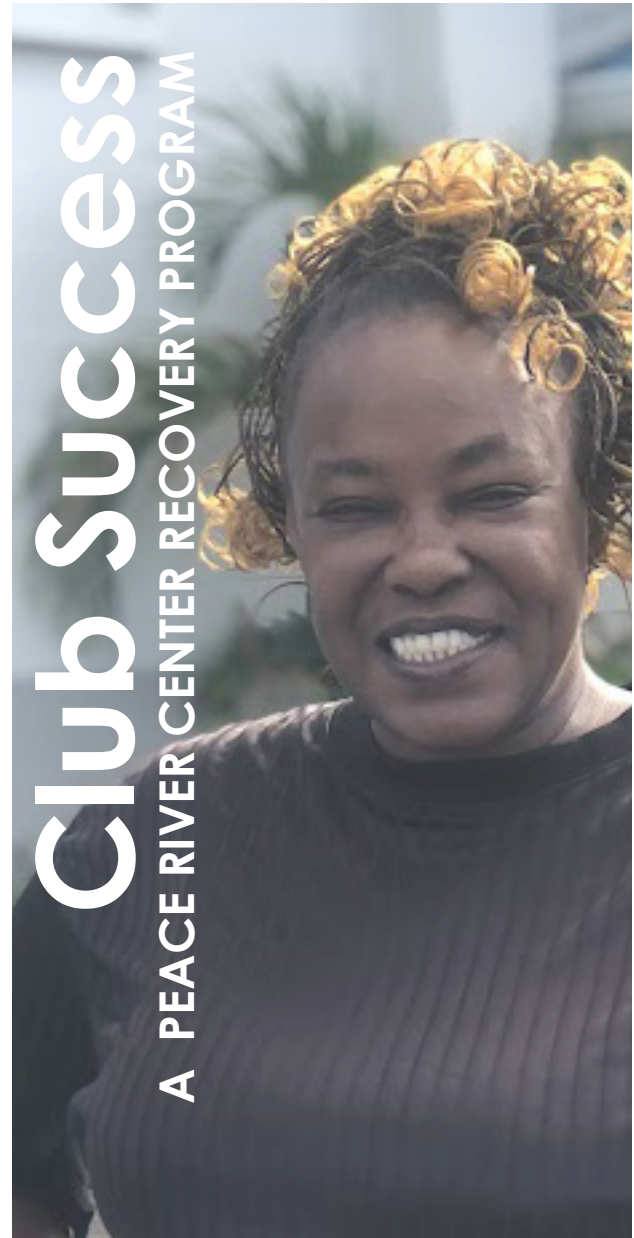
